HISTORY

The Sullivan Cup was established in 2012 as a biennial competition that rigorously and comprehensively tests individual and crew-level proficiencies.

In 2022, the Sullivan Cup expanded their armored vehicle team competition to incorporate Bradley Fighting Vehicle crews.
