

Basic Airborne Course (BAC) Graduation



Graduation will occur at "The Airborne Walk" at 0900 for classes that graduate from 01 APR to 30 SEP and 1100 from 01 OCT to 31 MAR. Normally, graduations will not occur on training or federal holidays, meaning graduation will occur on the last duty day of the week (usually a Thursday). Families/attendees should check the US Army Airborne School Facebook page or contact their graduate for the latest updates and changes to graduation timelines. For inclement weather or other unforeseen reasons, the graduation area, day or concept may change. If you wish to watch your student jump, jumps typically occur Monday starting at 1100 and 1600, Tuesday at 1300 and that night, and Wednesday at either 1300 or that night. Jump timelines are always subject to change due to a variety of factors.

Graduation General Rules

- Guests will only be allowed to interact with students for a short time during graduation and after release from the company.
- Some graduates will leave for their first unit later that day, TDY students will be released upon out-processing.
- Guests are not allowed within the Company Areas.
- DoD Policy strictly prohibits the issuance of blood wings.
- Guests are not authorized to park in the training area or drive on the track or side walks near company areas.

Seating Plan

- Families may seat anywhere within the bleacher area or stand
- If you know your Soldier's platoon, reference the picture to the right for seating. Please ask your graduate their roster number and platoon prior to graduation.
- Please reserve tent seating for those that need seats and may not be able to negotiate the bleachers

What to expect

- Silver Wings may conduct Military Freefall demonstration into the graduation area (weather pending).
- There will be an opportunity for those who are graduates of the Airborne School and are pinning a child or grandchild. These graduates will be identified and vetted before the ceremony. This is NOT for friends, leaders, non-Airborne graduate families, Drill Sergeants etc, only Airborne graduate parents and grandparents.
- There will be a second opportunity for everyone to come to the formation area to pin their graduate and take pictures.
- Soldiers will be released for the day once the company is done with their administrative tasks and a safety brief is given to those who are not shipping.
