

COL Scott Shaw
Director, Maneuver Capabilities Development and Integration Directorate



Colonel Scott Shaw, US Army, was born and raised in Little Rock, Arkansas. He graduated from the University of Arkansas in August 1996 and was commissioned as an Infantry officer. Upon completion of the Infantry Officer Basic Course, COL Shaw was assigned as a Rifle Platoon Leader with the 1st Battalion, 9th Infantry at Camp Hovey, Korea. Following his tour in Korea, COL Shaw was assigned to Ft Lewis, Washington where he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader and Company Executive Officer with the 1st Battalion, 24th Infantry, Assistant Operations Officer with the 1st Battalion, 5th Infantry, South Camp, Sinai, Egypt, and Aide-de-Camp to the Deputy Commanding General, I Corps.

In 2001, COL Shaw attended the Infantry Captain's Career Course and was assigned to Ft Drum, New York as the Assistant Operations Officer for the 2nd Brigade, 10th Mountain Division, followed by service as the Commander, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2nd Brigade, 10th Mountain Division deploying to Kabul, Afghanistan, and then Commander, Company A, 2nd Battalion, 14th Infantry Regiment deploying to Baghdad, Iraq.

Following command, COL Shaw taught as a Small Group Instructor in the Field Artillery Captain's Career Course at Ft Sill, Oklahoma. From Mar 2007-Jun 2008, he served as the Chief of Military Transition Team 235, FOB Normandy, Iraq.

After attendance at the US Army Command and General Staff College, COL Shaw served at Ft Hood, Texas as the Brigade Planner for the 1st Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, deploying to Taji, Iraq, Battalion Operations Officer for the 2nd Battalion, 5th Cavalry, Brigade Operations Officer for the 1st Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division deploying to COS Kalsu, Iraq, and Camp Buehring, Kuwait, and finally, Deputy Chief of Operations, III (US) Armored Corps.

COL Shaw commanded the Cottonbalers of the 3rd Battalion, 7th Infantry for 26 months from Jan 2014 to Mar 2016. COL Shaw served as the Director of Operations, Office of the Chief, Army Legislative Liaison in the Pentagon from May 2016-Jun 2017. COL Shaw then attended the Marine War College followed by service as Director of Legislative Affairs, Office of the Commander, US Forces-Afghanistan and Resolute Support Mission, Camp Resolute Support, Kabul, Afghanistan. COL Shaw commanded the US Army Asymmetric Warfare Group, Ft Meade, MD, from Jul 2019 to the unit's deactivation in May 2021. COL Shaw's previous assignment was Assistant Chief of Staff, G3, I Corps and Joint Base Lewis McChord.

COL Shaw holds three Master's degrees – Military History (With Honors) from Norwich University, Military Art and Science from the US Army Command and General Staff College, and Strategic Studies (Distinguished Graduate) from the Marine Corps War College.
