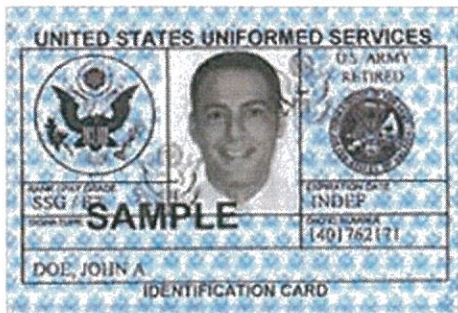


Active duty members of the Armed Forces, commissioned corps of Public Health Services (PHS) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

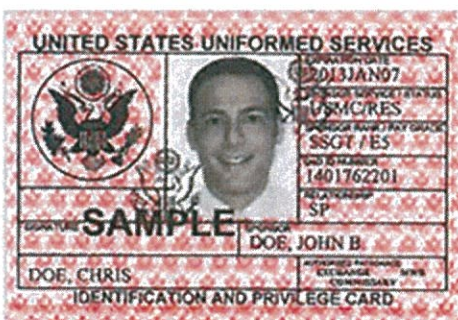
Reserve Component (RC) members of the Armed Forces of the United State who are pursuant to orders for more than 29 days, or on CLA approved emergency basic, in pursuant to orders for a period of 29 days or less.



Dependents of eligible persons.



Retired members of the Armed Forces, PHS, and NOAA who are entitled to or are receiving military retirement pay.



*Retired RC members are not eligible to receive legal assistance until they begin receiving retired pay (at age 60).

*Individuals presenting a military identification card indicating that the individual is a 100% disabled veterans are not eligible for legal assistance.

*ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR LEGAL SERVICES
