 - 1st Security Force Assistance Brigade & Military Advisor Training Academy

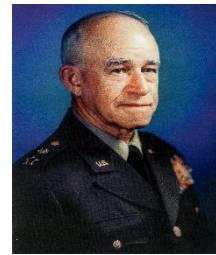

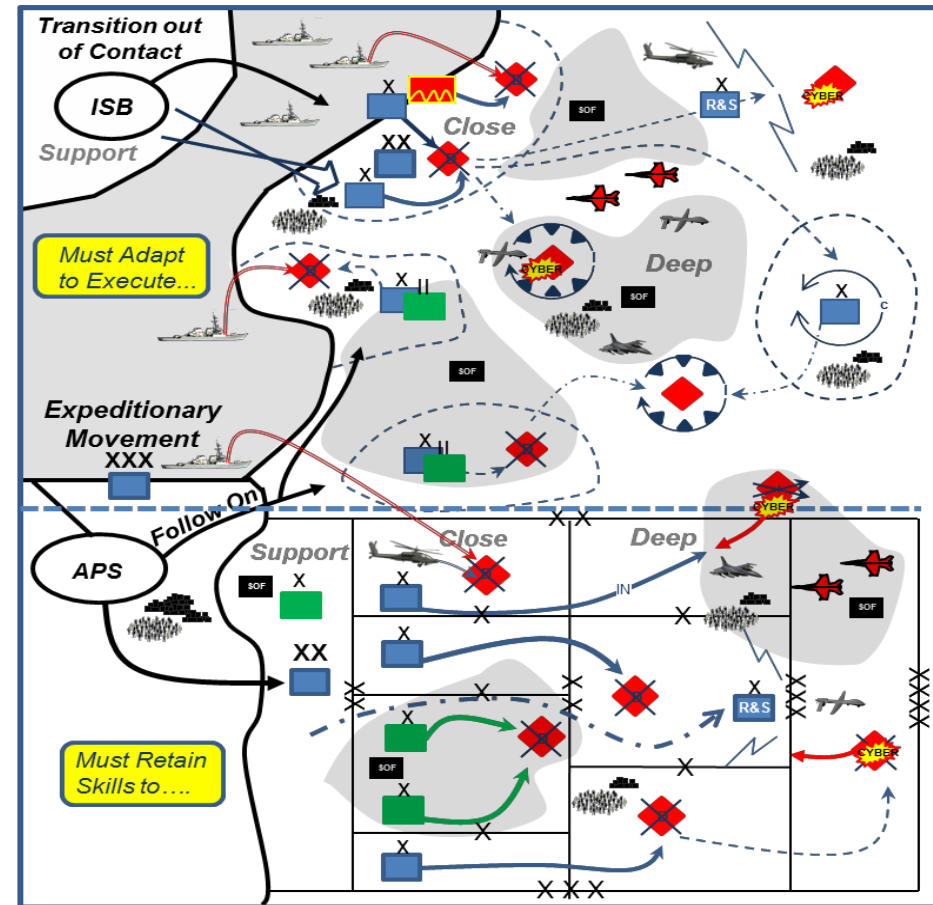
• MCoE produces trained, combat-ready Soldiers and leaders - **Main Effort**

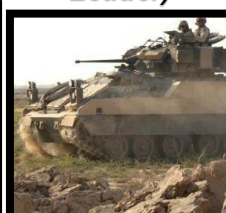

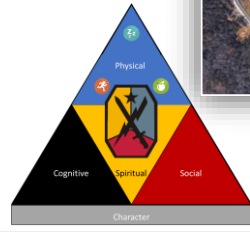

Economic/Community Impact

- Fort Benning ECONOMIC IMPACT to bi-state area = \$4.75 BILLION

- Fort Benning supports over 200k military, civilian, retiree and reserve personnel.
- Of the 9.5 Million (+) Population Of Georgia, 1 Million (+) are DoD Compensated.
