
# ARMY CAREER TRACKER

Users can search multiple Army education and training resources, monitor their career development and receive personalized advice from their supervisor and Army leadership.

**COOKIE INFORMATION:** ACT does not use persistent cookies (tokens that stay after session closeout and pass information between the client machine and the server). 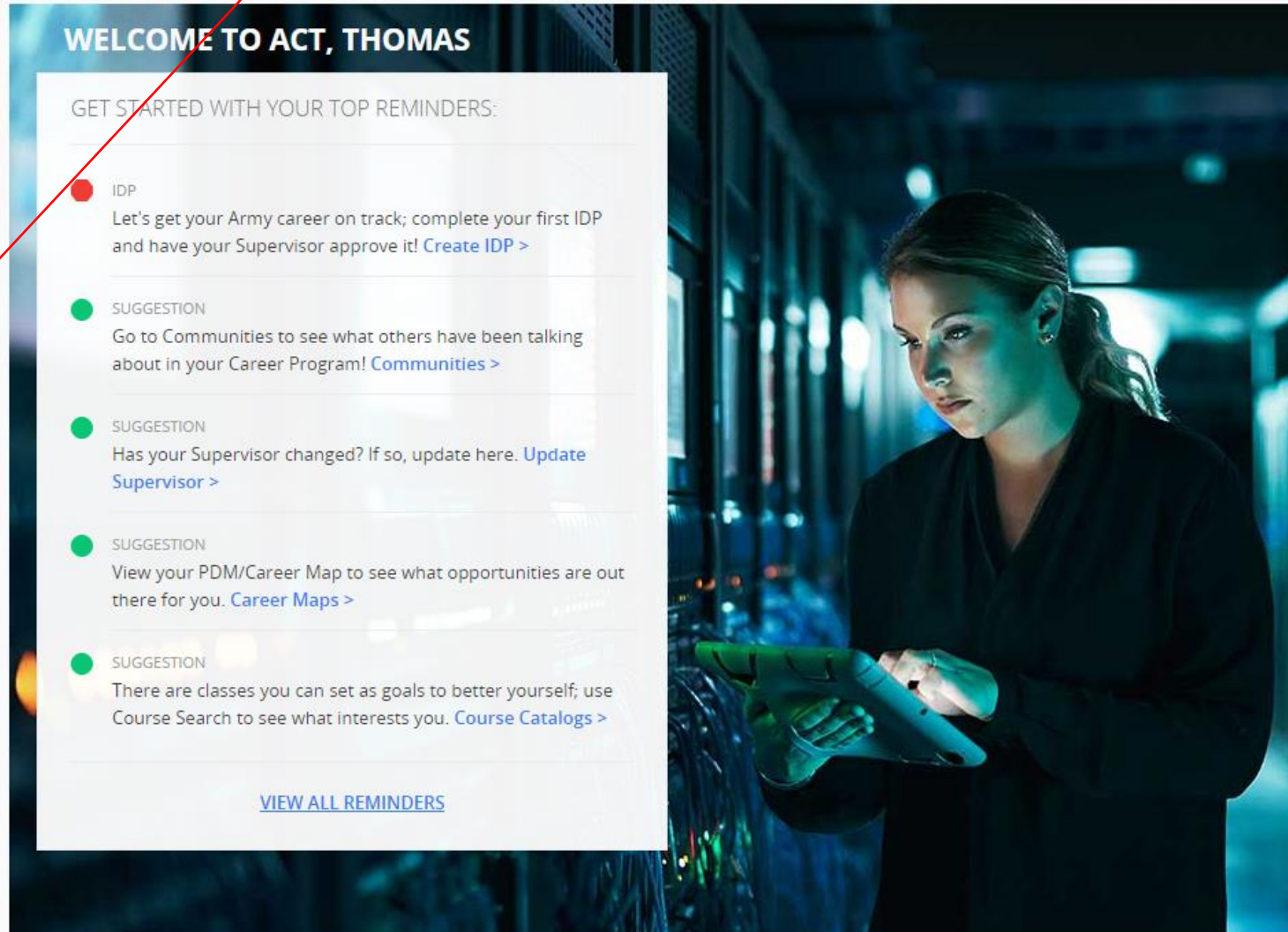

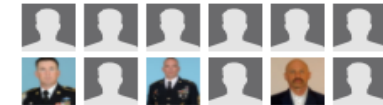
